You are receiving this letter because your company services grease control devices in Hampton Roads. We'd like to thank you for the service you provide to food service establishments in the region and ask for your support of local programs in place to keep our sanitary sewer systems flowing properly.

For several years now, localities across the region have been implementing programs in an effort to prevent the discharge of Fats, Oils and Grease (FOG) into the sanitary sewer system. The programs currently in place range from educational outreach to enforcement and inspection programs mandated by local FOG ordinances. As local programs continue to evolve, we need your support to ensure food service establishments have access to the information that is required of them.

The following information is required of food service establishments during their FOG inspections:

SMITHFIELD

- Hauler Company Name, Address and Phone Number
- Service Technician Name, Regional Grease Haulers Certification ID# (if available), and Signature
- Date of Service
- Disposal Destination of Waste
For example: not "HRSD" but "HRSD Suffolk Plant College Drive" or the stamp from that location.
- Reading from a "Sludge Judge" or Other Measuring Device
See illustration below of required measurements.
- Condition of Grease Control Device (GCD)
Condition is to be determined by visual inspection.



By providing your customers with this information, you are helping to ensure they operate under an adequate cleaning schedule, have proper documentation of all cleanings and required GCD maintenance, and remain in compliance with local ordinances.

Please note that some jurisdictions require each individual who hauls grease in Hampton Roads to carry the FOG Regional Grease Hauler Certification. This is a free certification for haulers that is available online through the www.HRFOG.com website. Once completed, recertification is required every three years.
