

AGENDA NOTE - HRPDC QUARTERLY COMMISSION MEETING

ITEM #6: STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PROGRAM – TOWN OF WINDSOR

SUBJECT:

The HRPDC has completed a stormwater plan for the Town of Windsor to meet the requirements of anticipated state stormwater regulations.

BACKGROUND:

A report entitled *Town of Windsor, Virginia Stormwater Management Program* has been completed to enable the Town to fulfill state stormwater management requirements and to meet its water quality objectives. Prepared under contract with the Town, the plan is the result of the cooperative efforts of the Hampton Roads Planning District Commission and Town staff. The plan provides the means to effectively address, to the maximum extent practicable, some of the common pollutants found in stormwater. It recommends a comprehensive program that includes pollution reduction activities for citizens, businesses, construction sites, and municipal operations. The program also includes participation in a regional public education effort (HR STORM) and targeted pollution reduction strategies. By addressing the pollutants and limiting the sources of such pollutants through the implementation of structural and nonstructural Best Management Practices (BMPs), the Town hopes to improve the water quality of its creeks and streams and protect the natural beauty and defining characteristics of its landscape.

Julia B. Hillegass, Senior Physical and Environmental Planner, will brief the Commission on the project.
