2. Hazardous Mitigation Process (Disaster Declaration Funds) Presentation

Mr. Robbie Coates, Virginia Department of Emergency Management, will make a presentation on the Disaster Declaration Hazardous Mitigation Application Process.

3. Virginia Stormwater Regulations Update

The Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) released its proposed revisions to amend Parts I, II, and III of the Virginia Stormwater Management Program Permit Regulations for a 30 day public comment period beginning March 28, 2011. HR representatives on the Stormwater Regulations RAP will brief the Committee on the major revisions to the Regulations. The Stormwater subcommittee members will develop a draft letter following their March 31, 2011 meeting. The letter will be made available to JEC members by April 5, 2011.

4. Stormwater Subcommittee Update

HRPDC staff will brief the JEC on items of interest resulting from the March 31, 2011 meeting of the Stormwater subcommittee.

5. Chesapeake Bay TMDL Special Meeting Update

HRPDC Staff will provide the Committee with an update from the March 31, 2011 Special meeting of the HRPDC regarding the Chesapeake Bay TMDL.

ACTION: None required

6. Climate Change Update

HRPDC staff is involved with a number of projects and efforts in the region related to climate change. Staff will give a presentation to the Committee on these projects, including an update on HRPDC climate change research and a report on a series of Sea Level Rise Listening Sessions in Virginia Beach.

ACTION: None required.

7. Environmental Impact Review Update

HRPDC has received a request for comment on the final draft version of the 2011 Regional Permit 5 (11-RP-05). 11-RP -05 authorizes the discharge of dredged or fill material in non-tidal waters of the United States, including wetlands and streams, for the construction of earthen dams and impoundments including attendant features such as mechanized land clearing, drainage ditches, roads, recreation and farm related features. The discharge must not cause the loss of greater than 1/2 acre of non tidal waters, including the loss of no more than 1,000 linear feet of stream bed. HRPDC staff requests comments from the Committee on the federal consistency determination for this permit.

HRPDC staff will provide a status report on several of the regional trail initiatives underway in Hampton Roads.

9. Plant More Plants Campaign Update

Plant More Plants, led by the Chesapeake Bay Program, aims to encourage residents in Hampton Roads, Richmond, DC, and Baltimore to adopt conservation landscaping behaviors that mitigate the harmful effects of stormwater runoff and ultimately improve the health of the Chesapeake Bay. HRPDC staff will provide the Committee with an update discussing HR Green's involvement with the Plant More Plants Campaign.

10. UPWP

Annually, the HRPDC staff prepares the Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) for the coming Fiscal Year. The UPWP describes the work activities the HRPDC staff will undertake in support of the Commission and member localities. HRPDC Deputy Executive Director, John Carlock will briefly summarize the FY 2012 UPWP.
