2. **Chesapeake Bay Phase II Watershed Implementation Plan (WIP) Update**

HRPDC staff will provide the Committee with an update on the Chesapeake Bay TMDL Phase II WIP process.

3. **HUD Sustainable Communities Regional Planning Grant Update**

In October 2011 HRPDC submitted an application for a Sustainable Communities Regional Planning Grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. HRPDC staff is scheduled to receive a debriefing on the application from HUD staff on January 31, 2012. HRPDC staff will brief the Committee on the findings from that discussion, as well as possible future regional sustainability efforts.

4. **Great American Cleanup Update**

Keep America Beautiful selected the Hampton Roads region, through partnership of askHRgreen.org and Keep Virginia Beautiful (KVB), as one of the national kickoff locations for

the annual Great American Cleanup, which marks the beginning of cleanup events in over 32,000 communities across the country. HRPDC staff will update the Committee on this initiative.

**5. Virginia Coastal Geospatial and Educational Mapping System (GEMS) Training**

Coastal GEMS provides extensive information on coastal resources in Virginia in the form of detailed descriptions and interactive spatial (mappable) data. It also offers a gateway, or starting point, for accessing more comprehensive coastal resource information from all of our natural resource agencies and coastal partners for consideration in planning efforts and management decisions. A major goal of Coastal GEMS is to foster stronger understanding of how activities on the land and in the water affect each other. It is the intent of Coastal GEMS to create a stronger linkage between local land use plans and state and federal water use policies. Nick Meade, Virginia Department of Environmental Quality, will provide the committee with a demonstration of the Coastal GEMS application.
