LRP Guiding Principles:



- **COLLABORATIVE** – a partnership of state government with local governments and their stakeholders
- **FACILITATED** – not dictated – by DEQ
- **REGIONAL** in focus – and tailored to address regionally-identified priorities
- **BOTTOM-UP**, not top-down

FOCUS



PDCs

Build on a foundation of successful efforts already undertaken by planning district commissions and other regional and local entities

Pilot Projects

Start with three pilot programs, and eventually extend statewide

Pilot Projects:



- **HAMPTON ROADS**
- **NEW RIVER VALLEY**
- **NORTHERN VIRGINIA**

Long range priorities & projects will be determined by each region



Some examples (from preliminary statewide interviews and surveys):

- Water Supply
- Water Quality (especially nonpoint source pollution)
- Energy Supply
- Climate Trends (such as extreme weather, recurrent flooding, salt water intrusion)
- Societal Growth (such as aging infrastructure, open spaces)
