 - Creating and sustaining affordable housing
 - Revitalizing low-income neighborhoods
 - Aiding the path to employment with workforce training and job-readiness skills
 - Financial literacy training
- **Education: DUE: February 15 through April 15, 2016**
 - eliminating the preK-12 achievement gap through services that support low- and moderate-income students, and providing mentoring and out-of-school programs
- **Environment: DUE: Feb. 15 through April 15, 2016 preservation through educational programming that teaches green practices**
- **Arts and culture: DUE: July 15 through September 15, 2016**
 - Support for art, science, and history organizations that advance education through school partnerships or outreach
 - Facilitating access to and participation in cultural experiences
 - Ensuring the availability of a broad array of artistic opportunities and venues that reflect the community's diversity
