2. askHRgreen.org Update

HRPDC staff will provide an overview of the second wave of askHRgreen.org research. The most recent survey is nearly identical to the benchmark survey, with the exceptions of a small number of new questions and removal of a section devoted to exploring media and communications use. The report compares responses from both surveys to measure changes in population behavior and the evolving effectiveness of the askHRgreen.org campaign.

3. Coastal Resilience Final Report

HRPDC staff received a Coastal Zone Management Program Competitive Grant to develop recommendations for promoting coastal resiliency and climate change adaptation in Hampton Roads. This grant has three components: performing public outreach and coordination, developing recommendations for incorporating climate change impacts into local and regional plans, and developing recommendations for a regional climate change adaptive management plan. HRPDC staff will brief the Committee on the final report's contents and recommendations.

4. Hampton Comprehensive Waterways Management Plan Presentation

Gayle Hicks and Sabrina Carr from the City of Hampton will brief the Committee on the Hampton Comprehensive Waterways Management Plan, a civic engagement project

which resulted in issue identification and short and long term strategies for shoreline protection, storm water management, dredging, tidal flooding and water quality improvement regulations.

5. Stormwater Memorandum of Agreement

The MOA for the Regional Stormwater Management Committee needs to be renewed prior to July 1, 2013. HRPDC staff will summarize the proposed changes and ask the Committee to recommend that the HRPDC approve the MOA to be distributed to locality CAO's for signature.

ACTION: Recommend that HRPDC approve MOA for distribution.

6. Unified Planning Work Program

HRPDC's Draft FY14 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) is open for public comment. The UPWP It is the result of input from the sixteen local governments served by the HRPDC and various state and federal planning requirements. The vast majority of the work elements evolved from local advisory and technical committees, with additional ideas, comments and suggestions generated at the HRPDC Retreat on February 21, 2013. Staff will brief the Commission on this item.

7. Coastal Zone Management Grants

The Virginia Coastal Zone Management Program anticipates allocating nearly \$120,000 for PDC Competitive Grants for FY 13-14. Applications will be due in late June to CZM. The HRPDC staff will brief the Committee on the program.
