

Update Current Plan

- ◆ Norfolk, Virginia Beach, Portsmouth, Suffolk and Isle of Wight (to include Windsor and Smithfield)
- ◆ Done every 5 years
 - ◆ Supported by FEMA FY10 Pre-Disaster Mitigation (PDM) Grant
 - ◆ \$125,000
 - ◆ Requires 25% match (in-kind or cash)
 - ◆ Prefer in-kind from salaries and local resources
 - ◆ Letters of Intent required
- ◆ HRPDC and consultant support




Updates to the Plan

- ◆ Land use information
- ◆ New/updated information on infrastructure/critical facilities
- ◆ Updated flood plain information to include available Digital Flood Insurance Rate Map (DFIRM) information
- ◆ Hazard vulnerability/risk and mitigation strategies for the localities in the region.
- ◆ Storm water management, man-made hazards, sea level rise, and mosquito borne disease outbreak analysis will be reviewed for inclusion


Hampton PDM Grant

- ◆ Received \$279,000
- ◆ Peninsula Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan
 - ◆ Hampton, Newport News, Williamsburg, James City County, and York County
- ◆ FEMA's request to expand footprint based on funds
 - ◆ Southside to be included upon approval
 - ◆ Create Hampton Roads Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan



Franklin & Southampton


- ◆ Hazard Mitigation Plans done in 2006
 - ◆ Each has a stand-alone plan
- ◆ Coordinating possible grant application with PDC and VDEM
 - ◆ Based on desires of localities, PDC will assist with grant application for FY10
- ◆ Cost estimated at \$25,000 (25% to be cash or in-kind match)



Recommendation

- ◆ Authorize the HRPDC Executive Director to:
 - ◆ Execute the Southside Pre-Disaster Mitigation grant application and supporting documents
 - ◆ When FEMA approves the re-scoping of Hampton PDM Grant, the Southside application will be pulled
 - ◆ Execute Franklin & Southampton Pre-Disaster Mitigation grant application and supporting documents
